



The Cricket Foundation Blake Hadden Memorial Scholarship 2022 Scholarship Eligibility Rules and Regulations

Statement of Purpose

The purpose of The Cricket Foundation Scholarship is to provide local area high school golfers with assistance in obtaining a quality four (4) year college or university education.

Scholarship Funding

The scholarship amount will be for the first year of college only and will be awarded to an incoming college freshman.

The scholarship funding will be used for the sole purpose of reimbursing the recipient for tuition, books, and fees. Cost of room / board and / or transportation are not included. In the unlikely event that the amount of the scholarship more than pays for the college related expenses, the scholarship recipient may petition the Foundation to use excess funds for other expenses.

Scholarship Eligibility

A candidate for the Scholarship must meet the following criteria:

1. Have a high school grade point average of no less than 3.0.
2. Have been a member of a high school golf team in the CSRA for at least one season. (Public and private schools that are within the CSRA). Schools must permit a representative of the Foundation Board to present the Scholarship at their School Awards Assembly.
3. Be accepted and plan to attend a four (4) year college or university.
4. Must not be the recipient of a full athletic or academic scholarship.

Scholarship Application Process

For the Foundation to consider a candidate for the Scholarship, he / she must agree to the following:

1. Write and submit an essay of 250-300 words. The purpose of the essay is to provide insight into the candidate's objectives in obtaining a college education and to explain the part golf has played in his / her life.
2. Provide the Foundation with a transcript of high school grades and S.A.T. or A.C.T. scores.

Scholarship Application Process – continued

3. Submit to the Foundation 3 letters of recommendation. One letter must be from a golf coach or athletic director. One letter must be from a teacher of an academic subject. **Letters must be specific and pertain to the applicant (no form letters).** There will be no extension for late letters.
4. Respond promptly to all Foundation requests for information including, but not limited to:
 - Information on all scholarships awarded to date for the upcoming Freshman year
 - Status of college plans for the upcoming year
5. Agree that the final decision of the Foundation regarding the recipient of the scholarship is binding and will not be challenged for any reason.

Scholarship Maintenance

1. The scholarship recipient will agree to attend any activities of The Cricket Foundation at a mutually agreed upon time and place. This includes any banquet or awards presentation.
2. The recipient will agree to allow his / her picture and biographical information to be used in press releases and other public relations activities consistent with winning a college scholarship.
3. The recipient must notify the Foundation of any change in contact information, including permanent address, email address, or phone number.
4. Prior to receiving the scholarship funds, the recipient must write a letter to the Foundation stating that he / she is not receiving a "full ride" scholarship for the upcoming academic year.
5. The recipient must notify the Foundation of any transfer between colleges or universities or if he / she is no longer attending college during their freshman year.
